When Terry Fox was diagnosed with osteosarcoma at 18, the experience ignited in him a fierce determination to bring an end to the suffering cancer causes. His personal experience and research led him to the conclusion that more money was needed for cancer research. And so, on April 12, 1980, Terry dipped his artificial leg in the Atlantic Ocean and proceeded to change the world.

Position Summary:

In support of the Terry Fox School Run, the Terry Fox Foundation provides motivational virtual school presentations delivered by a School Ambassador and other guest speakers via Zoom, MS Teams and Google Meet. The role of the Terry Fox Virtual Presentation Ambassador is to present virtually to schools participating in the Terry Fox School Run to help boost their fundraising efforts and kick off their event with a high energy, fun and inspiring presentation. The role also requires assisting guest speakers during their presentations with an introduction, Q and A, and closing.

Position Responsibilities:

- Create a virtual school presentation (approx. 20 min) using existing resources provided by The Terry Fox Foundation
- Deliver up to 3-4 virtual presentations daily from ON office located in North York
- Answer questions from students after each presentation (approx. 10 min)
- Revise list of attending schools for each presentation to identify schools for special mention during virtual presentations
- Work alongside 1 moderator (based in ON office) who will facilitate virtual presentations by introducing you, running Q&A session and concluding each presentation
- Ensure virtual platforms (Google Meet, Teams, Zoom) are set up and tested in advance of pre-set scheduled presentation dates
- Work through any tech issues on your end with the help of moderator

Skill Requirements:

- Able to deliver a high energy, engaging and fun presentation to students
- Comfortable public speaking to large audiences of school age children and teachers
- Computer and tech savvy/experienced in MS Office, specifically Outlook, Power Point, Google Calendar, Google Meet, Microsoft Teams, Zoom
- Ability to prioritize and multi-task within a highly efficient team environment
- Familiarity with the story of Terry Fox and a passion to support cancer research
- Ability to work a flexible schedule in late August – October (during high season, occasional early mornings and 1-2 evenings may be required)

- Excellent communication and presentation skills
- Public speaking experience
